HIROSHIMA DAY

Hiroshima day is observed on August 6th to commemorate the atomic bombing of Hiroshima, Japan in 1945 at the end of World War II. Hiroshima Day 2023 marks the 78th anniversary of Nuclear Explosion.

The Hiroshima day was observed in Blue Bird High School by class Discussion followed by quiz on the severe impact of these kind of explosions on humans as well as on the environment. Students were sensitized on the issue of environmental pollution due to various activities and the harmful impact of the use of chemicals on our daily life. The worst memories of Covid-19 still linger on leaving the world under great unrest.

This year's International Day for Disaster Risk Reduction addresses the connection between disaster and inequality with the theme 'Fighting inequality for a resilient future'. In order to sensitized our students about this special day, a mock drill was organized by the Disaster Management Club. The mock drill was organised in the early hours of the school. Instructions were conveyed to the students by the concerned teachers and the club members in advance on how they have to be got alert when the alarm will go on and move to the evacuation points according to the signs shown and the evacuation plan. It was conducted in a peaceful manner and helped students understand the early warning systems and disaster risk information.
