- 4. The Central Board of Secondary Education introduced skill subjects to make education more practical and career-focused. These subjects are important as they develop real-world skills, improve employability, and give students early exposure to different career options. Eligibility -

- Students with $\geq 75\%$ marks in Class IX/ Pre-board Result of Class X are eligible for direct the admission. Minimum eligibility can be relaxed for students who have extra achievements in co-curricular areas.
- Students with $< 75\%$ marks in Class IX/ Pre-board Result of Class X will be required to give an admission test. The admission test will consist of basic level questions from Arithmetic, English, General Science and General knowledge (conducted after board examinations)

Admission process-

1. Registration - Kindly collect the registration form and prospectus from school reception and submit duly filled form along with the necessary documents (view documents at bottom of this document)
2. Entrance Test / Interview Students who clear the eligibility criteria mentioned above will be required to take an interview (along with parents). The interview will be conducted by the coordinator (Senior Secondary Wing)
3. Results - Admission results will be communicated within 1-2 days of the interview. Parents will be required to submit admission fee within 2 working days or else admission will be forfeited.

Document Checklist

Self attested copies of the following documents must be submitted at the time of admission.

1. Pre-Board result of Class X/ Final Result of Class X/Final Result of Class 9th
2. Three latest passport size photographs of the student with the name and DOB written clearly on the reverse along with parents' passport size photograph.
3. Transfer certificate (in case student has completed Class X from another school)
4. Attested photocopy of birth certificate
5. Residence proof
6. Student's Aadhaar Card
7. Parents Identity Proof
8. Medical Report Form
9. MIS Portal TC (only for Haryana Schools)

Important

1. The submission of registration form is not a guarantee of admission. Admissions are governed based on the percentage criteria decided by school authorities for various streams, along with the written test and Interview.
2. All admissions to Class XI will be given on Provisional basis till the declaration of X Class result. Admission will be CONFIRMED after the student submits the original mark sheets, character certificate and the Transfer certificate on or before 15th July.

Scheme of Examinations and Pass Criteria for Class XI

Students must pass five main subjects, securing at least 33% in each (theory and practical exam separately).

Student failing in one or two subjects out of the five will be placed in the compartment category.

Student failing in more than two subjects out of the five will be placed in the Essential Repeat Category.

Attendance Requirement

All students are required to complete minimum 75% of attendance to be eligible to appear in the examination.

Scheme of Studies

Class XI and XII is a composite course. Students need to take only those subjects in class XI which he/she intends to continue in class-XII. Students can offer a minimum of 5 or more subjects in class XI. They need to continue the same subjects in class XII. The school will not entertain any request for change of Stream/Subjects/Status after the selection of the candidate for admission.

Scholarship

The school provides a scholarship to the meritorious students. Details are mentioned below. The school reserves the right to change the terms and conditions at any time after due intimation on school website.

S.No.	Category (in CBSE board results)	Scholarship details
1.	95%+	50% waiver on tuition fee
2.	90% to 94.5%	25% waiver on tuition fee
3.	75 to 89.5%	20% waiver on tuition fee
4.	60 to 74.5%	10% waiver on tuition fee

1. The continuation of scholarship next year will be subject to the review of Student's performance. The student must achieve at least a score equivalent to the category based on which scholarship was granted to him/ her
2. During any academic year, a recipient of any scholarship or benefit will not be eligible for any other new scholarship scheme or fee benefits announced for that particular academic year.
3. Students who avail the scholarship are required to complete the full term. In case the recipient is required to leave the school in the middle of the term, the student shall not be entitled to any scholarship.
4. Scholarship Committee reserves the right to change the terms & conditions at any time and display the policy on the school website.
