By following traffic signals, wearing helmets and seat belts, and avoiding distractions on roads, they promised to take a step towards a safer society.



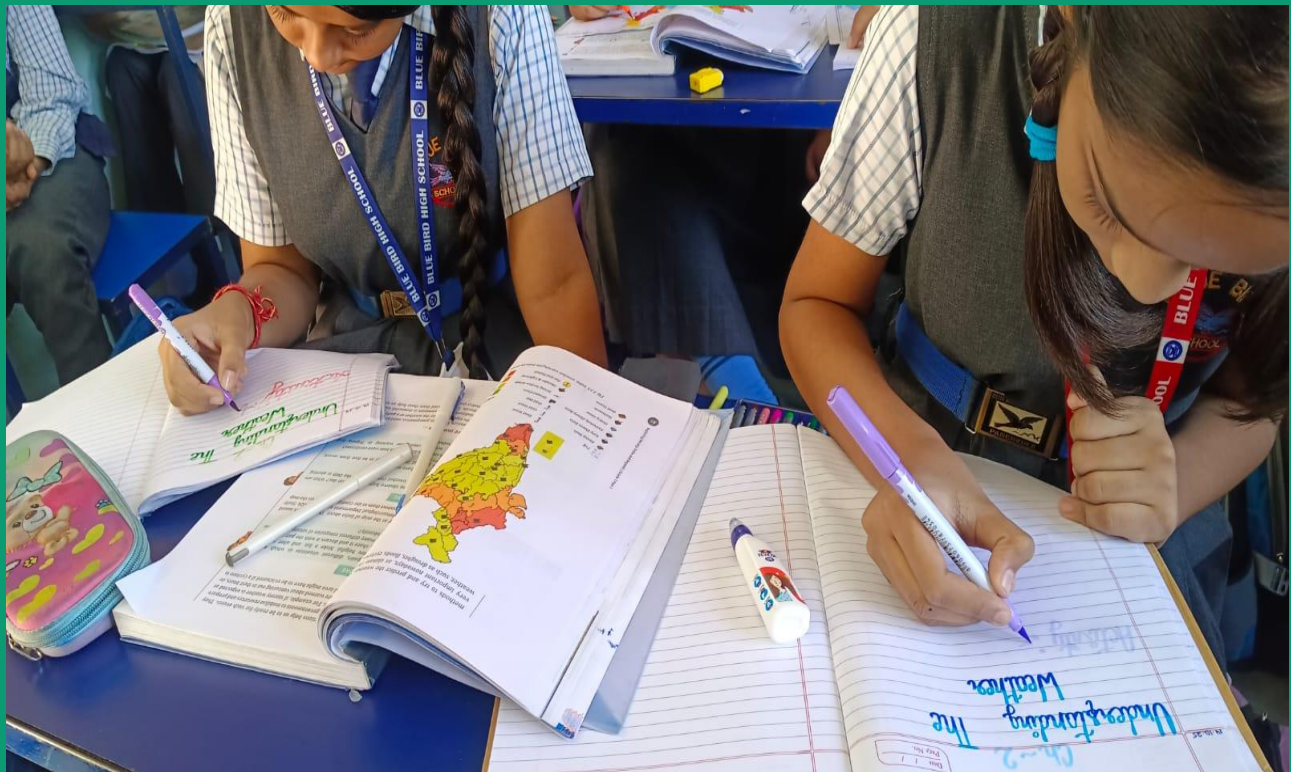


## Social Science Activity – Weather Warning System

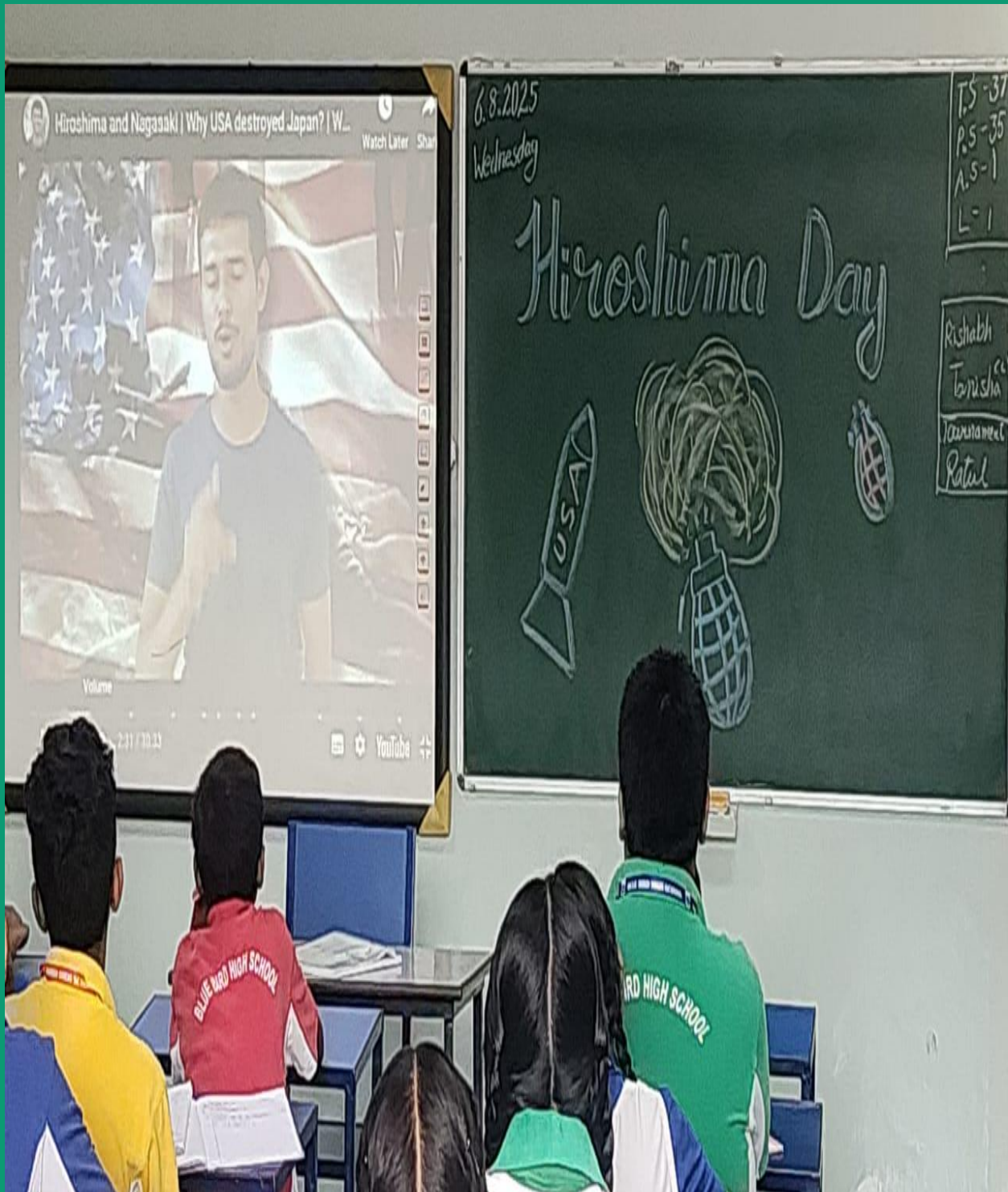

As a precautionary measure a Mock Drill was conducted for the students, to safeguard them from any such disaster like fire or earthquake. The program was designed to avert any kind of stampede, fear and panic. .**

**Students were trained to reach the safe designated areas allocated for each class in case of any emergency. The senior students assembled in the pre-allocated assembly areas.**

**Post evacuation, a head count was done by the class teachers to ensure the presence of everyone and to be assured that no one was left behind in the building. The drill focused on activation of the full response system and was followed by a review session.**
