- **2025 Theme:** "Heritage under Threat from Disasters and Conflicts: Preparedness and Learning from 60 years of ICOMOS Actions".



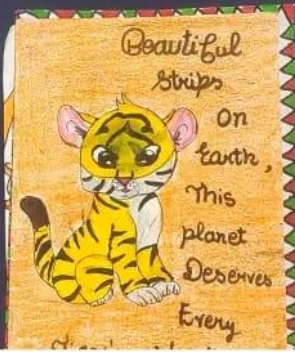
Baisakhi Celebration 2025
